PURPOSE


School Reopening after Hurricane Idalia

School Board members were briefed by Superintendent Edwards regarding his discussions with FLDOE about the reopening of Lafayette District Schools following Hurricane Idalia.


Superintendent Edwards expressed his concern for those students and staff who were still without power and discussed plans for how to meet some of those needs. After discussing many options for reopening schools, the Superintendent presented the school board with a plan to bring staff back on Tuesday and Wednesday, then open schools for students beginning on Thursday. Superintendent Edwards indicated that he would contact FLDOE for approval of this plan. No action was taken by the board.
