

MINUTES
LAFAYETTE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD
PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING, AUGUST 2, 2021

The Lafayette County School Board held their first public hearing on the 2021-2022 budget on Monday, August 2, 2021 beginning at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mr. Robert Edwards, Superintendent of Schools; Mr. Darren Driver, Member; Mr. Jeff Walker, Member; Mr. Taylor McGrew, Member; Ms. Marion McCray, Vice Chair was present via phone. Mrs. Amanda Hickman, Chairperson and Mrs. Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, School Board Attorney were absent. Administrators present were Mrs. Tammi Maund, Director of Finance.

CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Darren Driver called the public hearing to order at 6:00 p.m. Mrs. Tammi Maund presented a very informative review of the 2021-2022 budget. She explained the details of the millage rates, the budget as advertised, and the proposed Capital Outlay expenditures for the 2021-2022 school year. TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATES APPROVED AS ADVERTISED

- ✓ The tentative Required Local Effort rate of 3.43400 mills was unanimously approved on a motion by Mr. Taylor McGrew and a second by Mr. Jeff Walker.
- ✓ On a motion by Mr. Taylor McGrew and a second by Mr. Jeff Walker, the tentative Discretionary rate of .7480 mills was unanimously approved.
- ✓ The tentative Capital Outlay rate of 1.5000 mills was unanimously approved following a motion by Mr. Taylor McGrew and a second by Mr. Jeff Walker.

SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES RESOLUTION NO. 22-01

Mr. Taylor McGrew moved to approve Resolution Number 22-01 regarding adoption of tentative millage rates for 2021-2022. Mr. Jeff Walker seconded the motion which was unanimously approved. (Resolution on file in district office)

TENTATIVE BUDGET APPROVED AS ADVERTISED

The tentative budget, as advertised for the 2021-2022 school year, was unanimously approved on a motion by Mr. Jeff Walker, with a second by Mr. Taylor McGrew.

SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES RESOLUTION NO. 22-02

Mr. Jeff Walker moved to approve Resolution Number 22-02 regarding adoption of the tentative budget for 2021-2022. Ms. Marion McCray gave the second. The vote for approval was unanimous. (Resolution on file in district office)
