QUALIFICATIONS:

Ability to analyze quotes, bids and product specifications. Ability to work effectively with vendors and School Board personnel. Proficiency in the use of computers and related software in support of job functions. Knowledge of School Board policies and state regulations related to the purchasing function. Ability to communicate orally and in writing. Ability to plan, organize and establish priorities related to assignment. Ability to carry out job responsibilities and handle sensitive information in a confidential manner. Ability to work independently and make decisions with minimum supervision. Ability to handle multiple tasks in a professional and courteous manner. Ability to answer a telephone in a professional and courteous manner. Ability to work cooperatively with others.

Service Delivery

- *(1) Prepare bids and requisitions in accordance with local policies and state regulations.
- *(2) Review and evaluate commodity requisitions to ensure timely purchase.
- *(3) Maintain contact with vendors to ensure performance and follow-up on alleged discrepancies and non-performance.
- *(4) Initiate contacts with vendors and prospective vendors, maintain vendor bid lists, and adjust complaints.
- *(5) Demonstrate initiative in the performance of assigned responsibilities.

- *(6) Meet and deal effectively with the general public, staff members, parents, administrators and other contact persons using tact and good judgment.
